The House met pursuant to adjournment.

The journal of the previous legislative day was read and approved.

#### **INTRODUCTION OF BILLS**

The following bills were introduced:

**H. B. No. 231** - Representatives Williams, Miller, M. Cosponsors: Representatives Deeter, Fischer, Gross.

To amend section 5747.98 and to enact section 5747.74 of the Revised Code to create an income tax credit for employers that provide paid parental leave and to name this act the Paid Parental Leave Act.

H. B. No. 232 - Representatives Mathews, A., Thomas, D.

To amend sections 5715.19 and 5717.01 of the Revised Code to modify the law governing certain property tax complaints.

H. B. No. 233 - Representatives LaRe, Swearingen.

Cosponsors: Representatives Miller, K., Robb Blasdel, Williams, Newman, Stephens, Fischer, Click, Gross.

To amend sections 303.12, 303.59, 307.94, 3501.01, 3501.38, 3501.381, 3501.39, 3503.13, 3503.14, 3503.15, 3503.151, 3503.152, 3503.153, 3503.16, 3503.19, 3503.20, 3503.21, 3503.33, 3505.181, 3505.182, 3505.183, 3505.20, 3509.02, 3509.03, 3509.04, 3509.05, 3509.051, 3509.06, 3509.07, 3509.08, 3509.09, 3511.02, 3511.04, 3511.05, 3511.09, 3511.11, 3511.14, 3513.07, 3513.261, 3517.01, 3517.12, 3519.02, 3519.05, 3519.16, 3599.12, and 3599.21 and to enact sections 3503.201, 3503.202, and 3511.052 of the Revised Code to require verification of an elector's citizenship before the elector may vote and to modify procedures regarding voter registration, voter roll maintenance, absent voting, and election petitions.

To enact section 5534.607 of the Revised Code to designate a portion of State Route 2 in Ottawa County as the "Cpl. Robert Dockstader Memorial Highway."

**H. B. No. 235** - Representatives Lawson-Rowe, Brewer. Cosponsors: Representatives Brennan, Piccolantonio, Brownlee, Lett, McNally, Rader, Russo, Sweeney, Synenberg, Upchurch, Williams.

To amend sections 5747.08 and 5747.98 and to enact sections 5747.87 and 5747.88 of the Revised Code to authorize a nonrefundable income tax credit

for the cost of handgun training and firearms storage and locking devices.

H. B. No. 236 - Representative Williams.

To amend sections 2152.17, 2911.21, 2917.02, and 2929.14 and to enact sections 2917.10 and 2941.1427 of the Revised Code to prohibit masked harassment and masked trespassing, to modify the offense of aggravated riot when the offender is wearing a mask or disguise or is otherwise concealing or attempting to conceal the offender's face, and to require an additional prison term of one year for an offender who is convicted of or pleads guilty to a felony if the offender is convicted of or pleads guilty to a specification that the offender wore a mask or disguise or otherwise concealed or attempted to conceal the offender's face in commission of the offense.
